

HOUSEKEEPING RULES

of the International Book Fair in Warsaw

May 28–31, 2026

1. The following terms shall have the meanings assigned below:
 - a) **Fair** – the International Book Fair in Warsaw, held at PGE Narodowy Stadium, al. Księcia Józefa Poniatowskiego 1, 03-901 Warsaw.
 - b) **Organizer** – the Historia i Kultura Foundation, with its registered office at ul. Kozia 3/5 lok. 31, 00-070 Warsaw, entered into the National Court Register (KRS) under number 0000200140, maintained by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw in Warsaw, 12th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, holding NIP: 5272429990 and REGON: 015695186.
 - c) **Regulations** – these Terms and Conditions of the Event.
 - d) **Premises** – the area where Exhibitors occupy their exhibition stands, including autograph zones, stages, and forums.
 - e) **Stage/Hall/Forum** – a designated space for meetings between Participants and authors.
 - f) **Event** – a meeting between Participants and an author.
 - g) **Exhibitor** – an entity authorized by the Organizer to arrange an exhibition stand and present and sell publications.
 - h) **Participant** – any person present on the Premises.
2. **Minor Participant** – a participant under 13 years of age.
3. Entry to the Fair is permitted upon purchase of an admission ticket at ticket offices during the event or in advance via the websites www.eBilet.pl or <https://targi-ksiazki-warszawa26.exposupport.pl/shop-1>.
4. A separate ticket must be purchased for each day of the Fair.
5. The Fair offers 1-day tickets and 4-day passes. A 1-day ticket entitles the holder to enter the Fair only on the date for which it was purchased. A 4-day pass entitles entry on all four days of the event.
6. A family ticket entitles entry for 2 adults and up to 3 children (under 18 years of age).
7. A group ticket entitles entry for school groups (under 18 years of age) consisting of 5 to 25 persons, accompanied by up to 3 adult guardians.
8. The Organizer warns that presentation of a counterfeit or damaged ticket will result in refusal of entry to the Event.
9. The Organizer warns that presentation of a counterfeit or damaged ticket will result in refusal of entry to the Event.

10. Free admission is granted to children under 7 years of age, persons with disabilities together with one caregiver, and journalists and influencers upon prior accreditation. Librarians and booksellers are granted free admission upon prior accreditation only on May 28–29, 2026.
11. Opening hours for Visitors:
- May 28, 2026 (Thursday): 10:00–18:00
 - May 29, 2026 (Friday): 10:00–19:00
 - May 30, 2026 (Saturday): 10:00–19:00
 - May 31, 2026 (Sunday): 10:00–17:00
12. Entry to the Premises and participation in the Fair are subject to the following conditions:
- a) reading, accepting, and complying with these Regulations; entry to the Premises constitutes acceptance of these Regulations;
 - b) following instructions issued by persons responsible for organizing the Event, including security services and Fair staff;
 - c) Minor Participants may attend only under the supervision of adult Participants;
 - d) it is prohibited to bring or possess weapons, flammable materials, explosives, pyrotechnics, or other similarly dangerous items, as well as alcohol, narcotics, psychotropic substances, or other similar substances. The classification of items as dangerous is at the discretion of security services and Organizer representatives.
13. Events (author meetings) are held under the following rules:
- a) Participants may not bring their own seating (e.g., folding chairs, blankets, mats) and must occupy seats designated by the Organizer;
 - b) chairs must not be rearranged;
 - c) due to limited seating, availability is determined on a first-come, first-served basis.
14. During the Fair, all Participants are obliged to:
- a) comply with safety and public order rules;
 - b) respect public property and greenery and refrain from littering;
 - c) behave in a manner that does not endanger the safety of other Participants or third parties.
15. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or behaving in a way that endangers others, disrupts the Fair, or violates generally accepted standards of public conduct, will be removed from the Fair by the Organizer’s representatives.

16. During the Fair, it is prohibited on the Premises to:
 - a) engage in unauthorized vending or provision of services, including food services, other than those offered or approved by the Organizer;
 - b) distribute promotional materials (including leaflets, posters, or other media), except those distributed by the Organizer and Exhibitors;
 - c) conduct political or religious campaigning, demonstrations, protests, or other forms of public expression of views;
 - d) consume narcotics, psychotropic substances, or similar substances;
 - e) consume alcohol;
 - f) cross safety barriers;
 - g) enter the Stage.
17. The Organizer shall not be liable for valuable items left on the Premises.
18. The Organizer is the controller of Participants' personal data.
19. Participants acknowledge that they are attending a public event, and entry to the Premises constitutes consent to the recording, distribution, and use of their image or statements captured during the Fair in visual or audiovisual form for the purposes of photographic documentation, documentary films, interviews, and coverage of the Fair, as well as for statutory, documentation, marketing, promotional, or advertising purposes of the Fair, the Organizer, and Exhibitors.
20. The legal basis for processing Participants' personal data is the legitimate interest of the Organizer in achieving the purposes indicated above (Article 6(1)(f) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 – General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR).
21. Participants assume responsibility for their participation in the Fair. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Organizer's liability for damages related to participation in the Fair is excluded.
22. The Fair staff or security services may at any time, without giving reasons, refuse a Participant entry, request them to leave the Premises, or remove them if they fail to comply. A ban on participation may be imposed if a Participant poses a threat to themselves or others, violates these Regulations, or fails to follow instructions.
23. All rights to the name and logo of the Fair are reserved by the Organizer.

25. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Regulations.
